

## DOWNTOWN PAGES: YOUR DOWNTOWN GETS THIS CITY'S FIRST GREEN ROOF AMIDST A PLETHORA OF SEASONAL ACTIVITIES!

BC Place's roof refit may be floating in thin air, however here in your Downtown, Kevin Simoes and his Streamline Enterprises team will be installing their new "green roof" at 2644 Montrose Avenue on September 28. The roof panel is currently being pre-vegetated in a local nursery. Did you know that Streamline is also installing the very first vertical community garden project in Canada? The 60 sq. ft. green living (edible crop) wall, modeled after similar successful projects in Los Angeles and New York, will be located at Blood Alley Square in Vancouver's Downtown Eastside and was spearheaded by the non-profit Environmental Youth Alliance.

Kevin and company have exclusive distribution rights for green roofs and walls ([www.agreenroof.com](http://www.agreenroof.com)) to Canada and Iran, and with agents and upcoming projects in Ontario and Alberta, while other Streamline projects nearing completion include: a 68,000 sq. ft. one for Sysco Foods (currently on the ground being pre-vegetated); 3200 sq. ft of roof on Park side Victoria (new LEED platinum building) 4000 sq. ft. green roof & 200 sq. ft. living on new roof top patio on Granville St. and a 200 sq. ft. living wall in a private residence in downtown Vancouver.
